Demokratie leben! Herford

Since 2015 the Hanseatic city of Herford is actively involved in a nationwide project called "Demokratie Leben ", which focuses on the fight against right-wing extremism, violence and misanthropic ideas. This project aims to promote civilian engagement and democratic behaviour at the municipal, regional and supranational level. Attacks on democracy, freedom and the rule of law as well as ideologies of inequality are permanent challenges for society as a whole. Right-wing extremism, racism and anti-Semitism, the challenges of Islamic and Muslim hostility, anti-gypsyism, ultra nationalism, homophobia, violent salafism and jihadism, left-wing militancy and other areas all show the multitude of democratic and anti-human phenomena. In order to oppose them vigorously, there is a need for joint efforts by the state and civil society.

The Hanseatic city of Herford is one of Germany's 234 municipalities in the program "Partnerschaft für Demokratie", which supports cities and municipalities throughout Germany in developing and implementing action plans for the promotion of democracy and diversity through local partnerships. With around 55,000 € annually, the city will now be building up a local alliance that is designed to develop an overall strategy which is to be realized in the context of different projects and actions.

The project is managed by the youth welfare office of the Hanseatic city of Herford. A co-ordination center has been set up to co-ordinate individual measures with regards to form and content. It is responsible for managing the implementation of the local "Partnerschaft für Demokratie", acts as a contact and contributes to the promotion of local measures. Through appropriate measures, the work of the "Partnerschaft für Demokratie" is to be made known to a broad public and to be advertised for participation.

Within the framework of the targeted networking, civil society stakeholders from the region will also be actively involved in the development and updating of the "Partnerschaft für Demokratie". To this end, a local Democracy Conference will be held twice a year to invite all relevant civil society actors, institutions and leaders from politics and administration to participate by reflecting and determining on the status, objectives and direction of further work in the program.

In order to strengthen the participation of young people in relation to this program, various youth platforms will be established as well as organized and managed by young people themselves. To implement their own measures, individual subsidies are made available to these youth platforms.
