ECCAR WORKING GROUP ON COMBATING ANTISEMITISM

- Cooperation between the City of Dortmund & ECCAR Office
- Kick-Off September 2021
- More than 20 cities from 10 countries participated







COLLECTION OF GOOD PRACTICES BACKGROUND AND FRAMEWORK

- EU Strategy on Combating Antisemitism and Fostering Jewish Life (2021–2030) + EU Anti-Racism Action Plan 2020–2025
- Coordinated by ECCAR Office Heidelberg
- Collaboration with WG on Antisemitism & CEJI A Jewish Contribution to an Inclusive Europe
- Funding of around 60.000 € by European Commission
- Kick-off Februrary 2022
- Duration: 18 months

- Identification of the main approaches and challenges
- Elaborating recommendations how local European governments can take action against antisemitism and secure and foster Jewish life
- Provide practical guidance and a knowledge pool for local European authorities



SURVEY FINDINGS INSTITUTIONALIZATION

7 out of 37 respondents mentioned some level of institutionalization in the city administration:

- Dedicated post or office which is explicitly charged with addressing antisemitism; and/or
- An established policy framework explicitly dealing with antisemitism.





SURVEY FINDINGS COOPERATION WITH JEWISH COMMUNITIES










SURVEY FINDINGS OVERVIEW OF POLICY AREAS










SURVEY FINDINGS CHALLENGES FACED BY THE CITIES

Challenges faced by the cities










SURVEY FINDINGS AREAS FOR FURTHER CAPACITY BUILDUING

COLLECTION OF GOOD PRACTICES LEARNINGS

- Best practice exchange and capacity building on a local level is needed
- Measures and projects must be embedded in long-term structures -> Institutionalization
- Resources and staff needed
- Need for more measures and bodies that specifically address antisemitism
- More focus on contemporary Jewish life
- For more geographical balance we need more answers




